



## Dr. Gregory C. Sales (Greg)

His academic preparation includes:

- A Bachelor of Elementary Education degree from the University of Alaska, in Fairbanks, Alaska,
- A Master of Mathematics Education degree from Miami University, in Oxford, Ohio, and
- A Doctorate of Philosophy degree, with a specialization in instructional design and technology, from the University of Minnesota, in Minneapolis, Minnesota.
