Proposed Project Name	<p>Assessment Tools for new learning environments in higher education institutions - ASSET</p> <p>Core Objective: The project aims at revising and evaluating existing assessment methods, developing a system of teaching and evaluation that best suits students' learning needs. As a result of the project academic personnel will be trained by beneficiary Universities and introduction of new assessment tools for training programs.</p>
Project Activities and Outcomes	<p>Project Activities include:</p> <p>Creating and implementing formative CATs (course assessment tools) to Enhance learning/teaching process at Partner HEIs. Beneficiary institutions will design and develop general framework for CATs and new assessment methodologies.</p> <p>Creating a new generation of CAT specialists by developing CAT's training manual and organizing Train-the-Trainer workshops. At least 4 faculty per HEI will be trained at EU-hosted course assessment development trainings. Additionally, national meetings for peer consultation and sharing best practices and peer mentorship will take place as well resulting in multiplier effect (~10 faculty per HEI). 2 to 4 courses will be tested using innovative CATs to map the CATs to the GE and IL system for increasing the impact in student performance.</p> <p>Elaboration of CAT's handbooks. Based on the piloting results all GEO HEIs will contribute in elaboration process of CAT handbook.</p>
